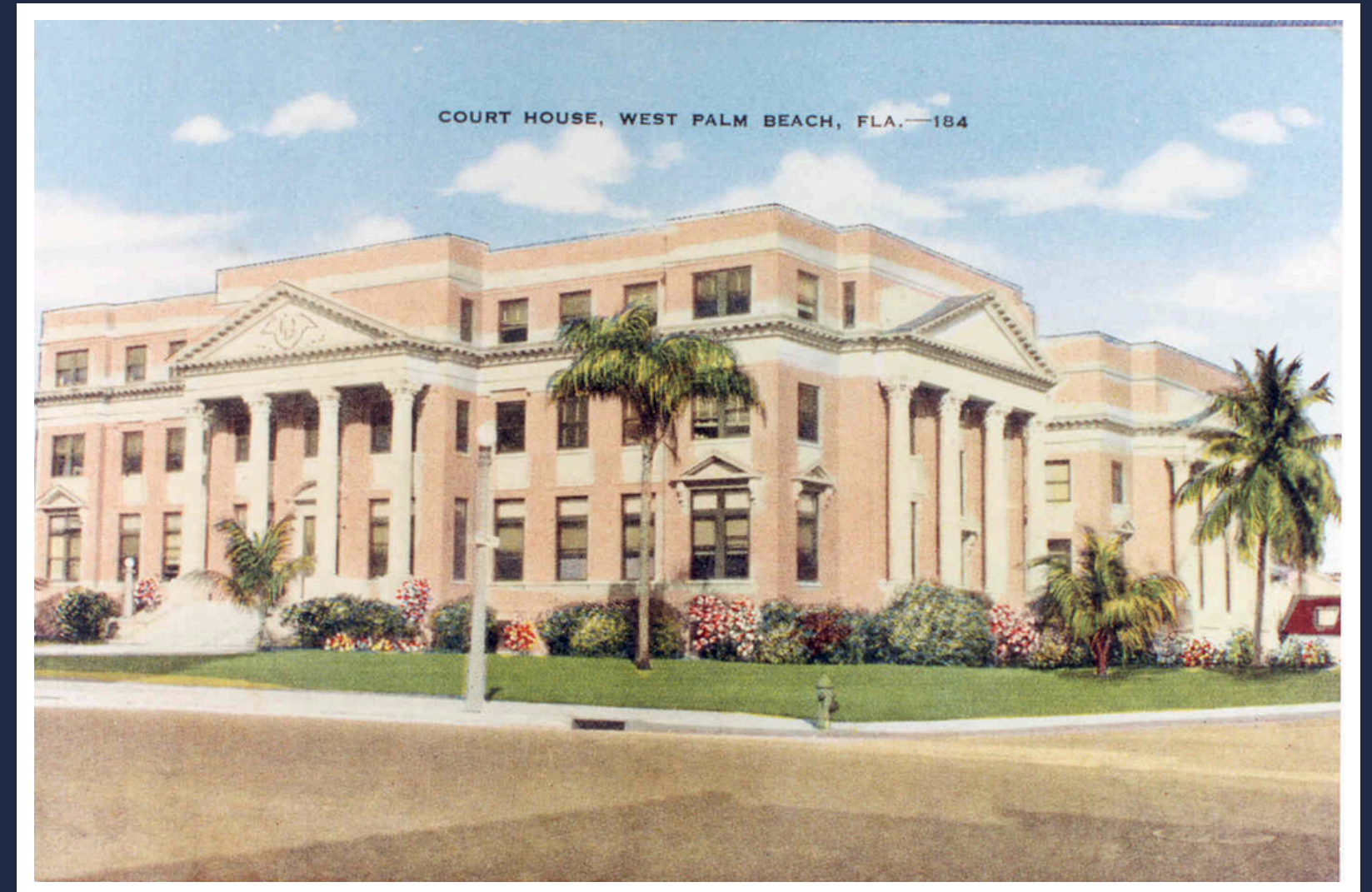

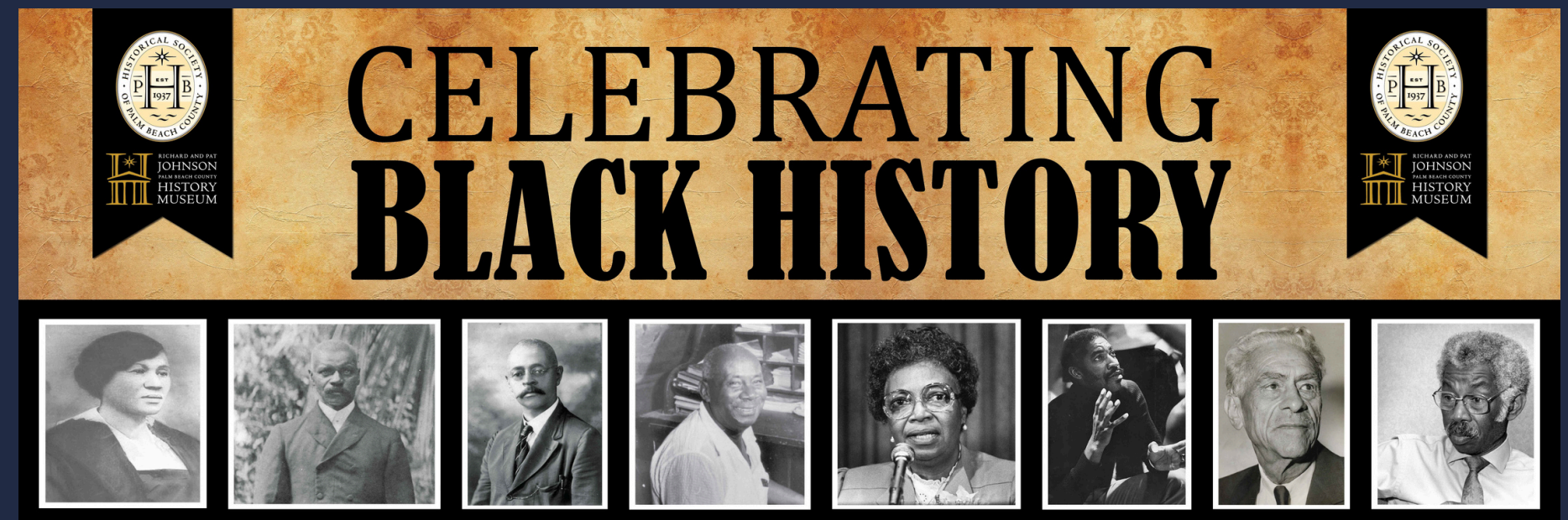
February 2, 2026 - February 28, 2026

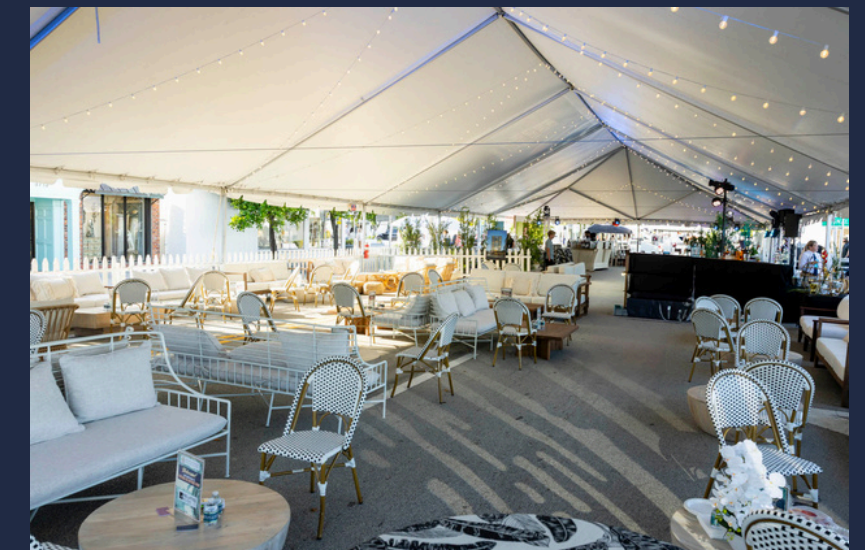
